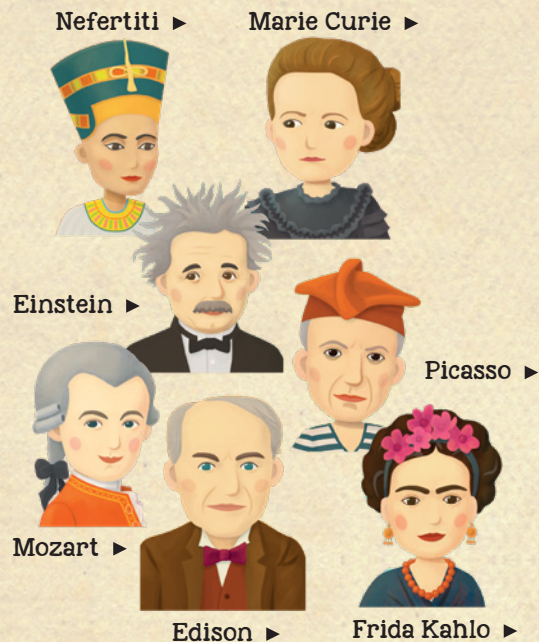


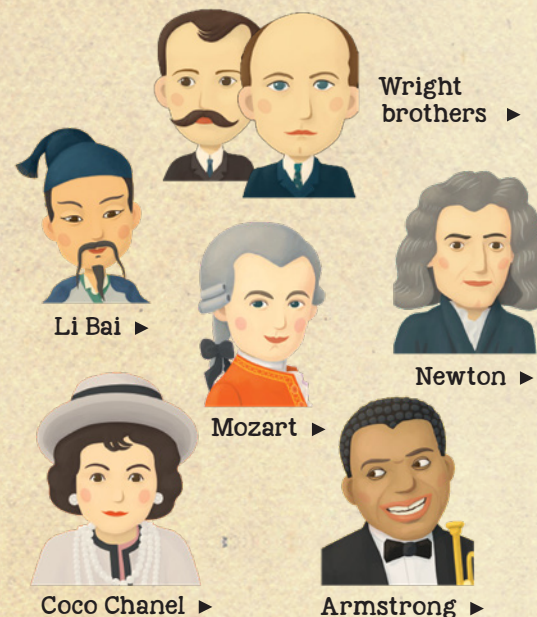

So many famous people in one spot! Can you match the individuals with what they looked like as children?



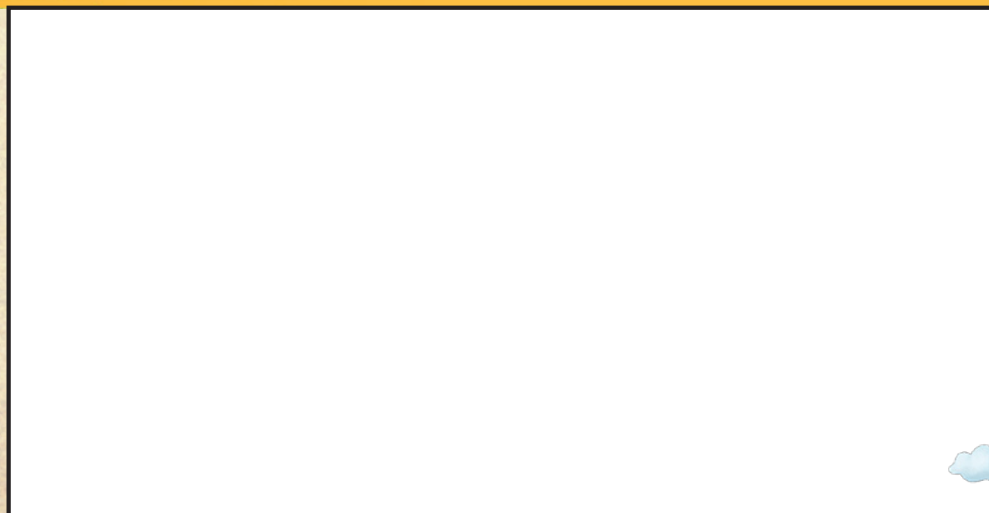

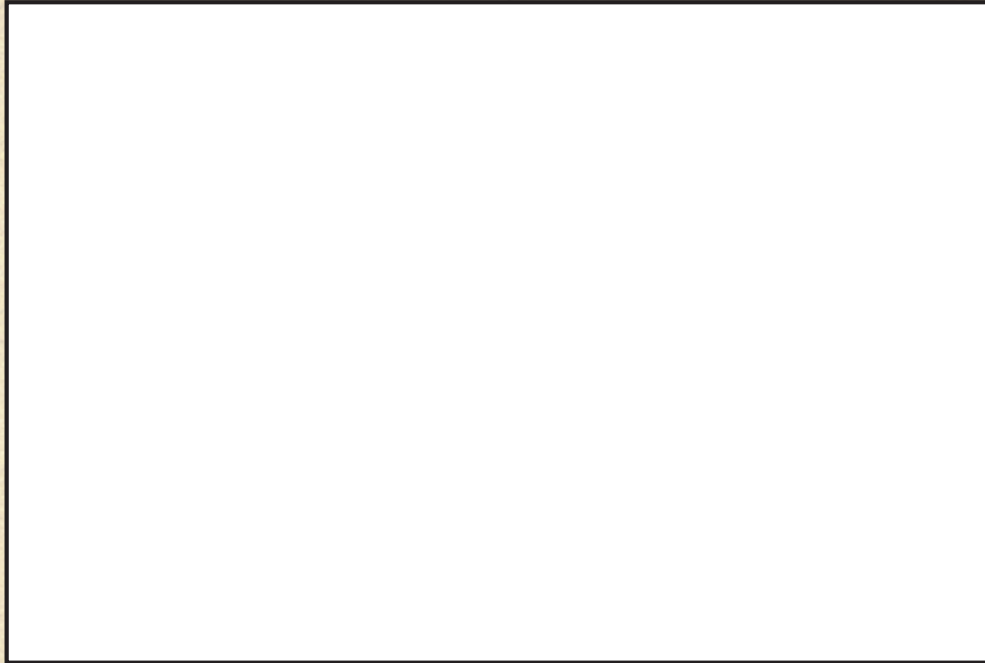

Play-act as the famous designer Coco Chanel and design a ceremonial dress, a motley track suit, or a vibrant hat.



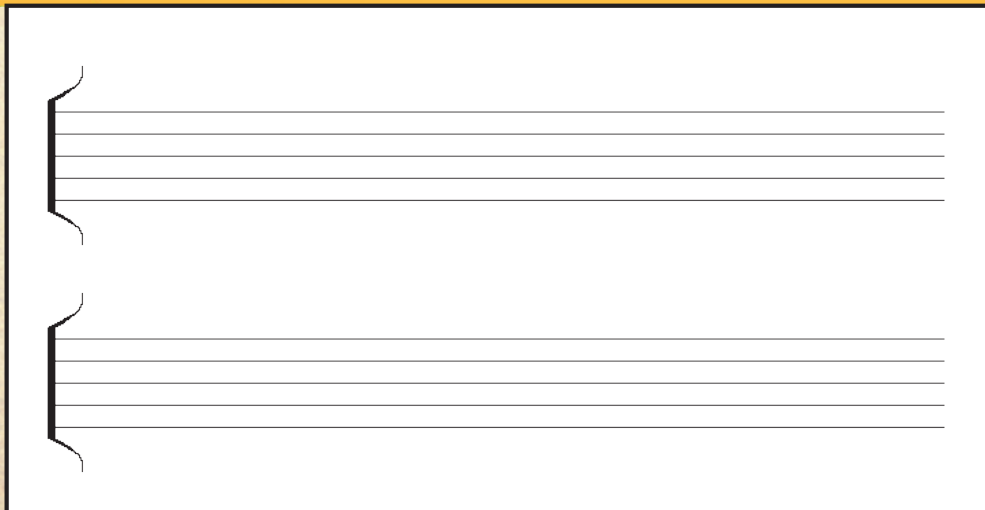

Use your imagination to colour in one of the self-portraits of the famous painter Frida Kahlo.



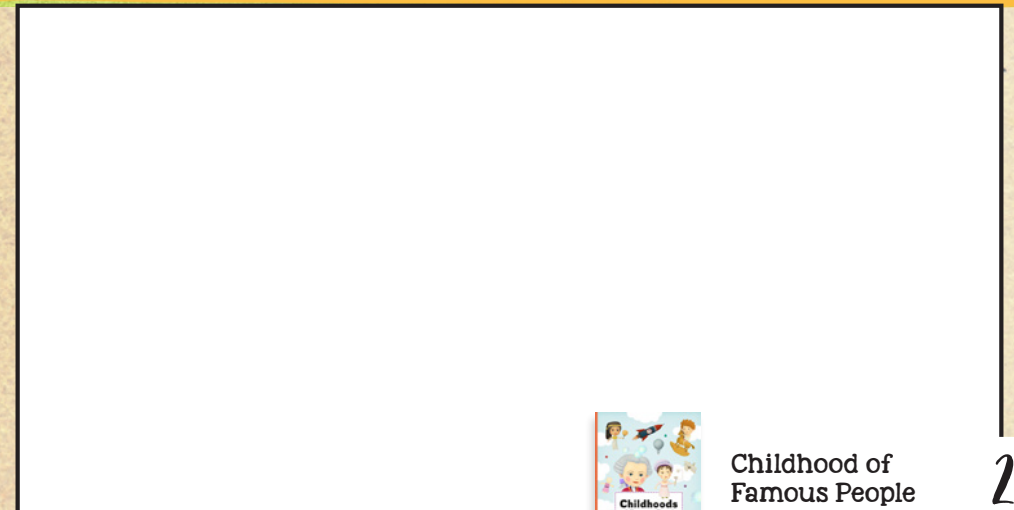
