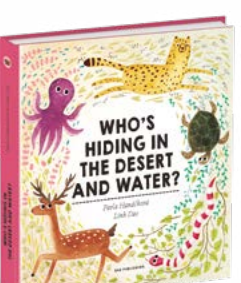


Wild Animals from a Swallow's Eye View

Snail Racing

Getting ready for the race

Snail races require a thorough preparation, just like any other sport. My coach makes me work out every morning, holding me in her two fingers and exercising my foot by spreading them. Why? Because my entire foot is made out of muscle. Other times, she lays a piece of cucumber in front of my horns and times how long it takes me to reach it. My shell, too, needs to be kept sufficiently fit (in case a racer who's faster than me hits it ...). That's why I eat cuttlebone or baked eggshells to have enough calcium intake.

Work out:

flash sweats by proper stretching. Give it a try! First, take 10 steps, as slowly as you can. Put a stuffed animal on the ground to mark where you ended up. Then go back to the start, lie on your stomach and try to reach the animal by crawling over. Just like a snail



i Ready, steady, slow!

1st minute: Racers, take up your starting positions, we're about to begin! Are you ready to set out at the fastest speed you practiced at home? You are? Great, let's do it, then! 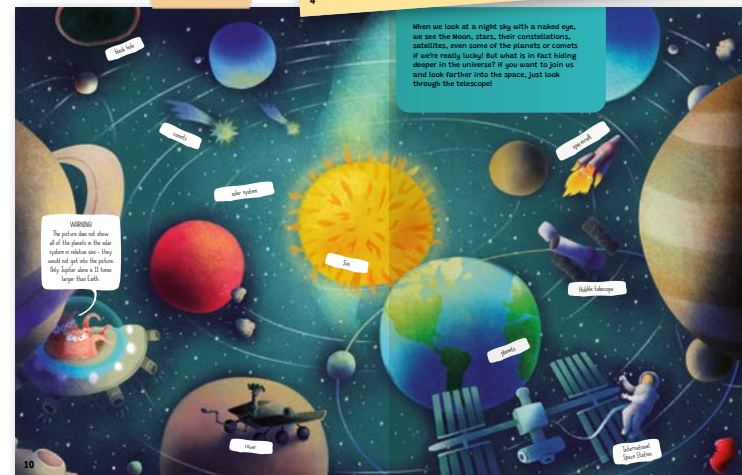

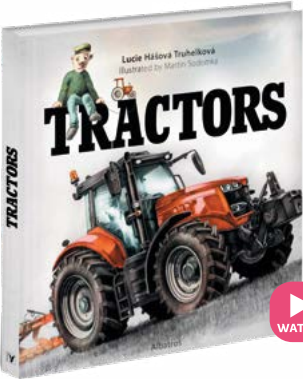

4 Sowing

It is said that we reap what we sow. To get a good yield, it is very important to sow properly. A sloppy sowing job may result weeks later in a field where nothing grows. Fortunately, the **seed drills** in use today take good care that the job is done well. Attached to the back of a tractor, their underside has **discs** that loosen the soil. Once the soil is prepared, so-called **seed coulters** under the discs plant the grain or other seed, such as clover, alfalfa or flax, before covering it with soil. The farmer sets the amount of grain he wishes to plant in advance, using special controls in the tractor's cabin. Hydraulic arms with a wide reach can seed a field **12 metres** wide in no time. What's more, some seed drills can fertilize the seed right away!

7 Turning and tending

Mown grass, clover and alfalfa must be turned before they can dry properly. In the past, this had to be done by hand, meaning that every member of the farmer's family got to work with a rake. These days, all the farmer must do is attach a **turner** – a modern kind of rake – to his tractor. The turner in the picture has **six rotors**, but some turners have twelve. Each rotor has seven arms, and each arm has metal fingers. When these tilt and spin, watch the hay fly! A turner can turn mown fodder over a range of almost eight metres at one time. As for the **tender**, it has just one or two rotors, but these rotors are bigger than those of a turner. It moves across a meadow turning hay into regular rows. Once it has finished, everything is ready to harvest.

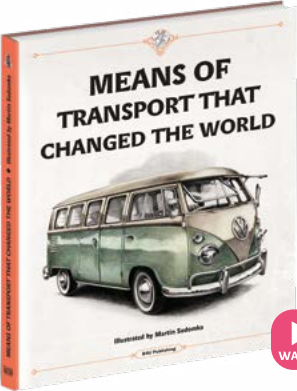

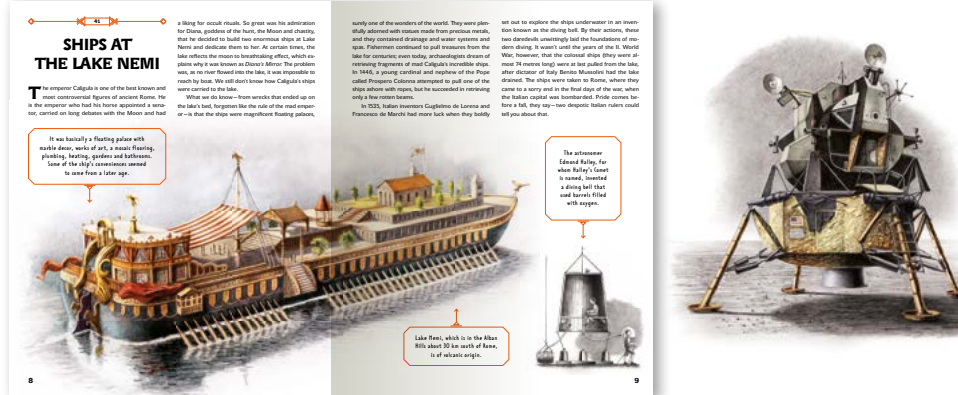

SHIPS AT THE LAKE NEMI

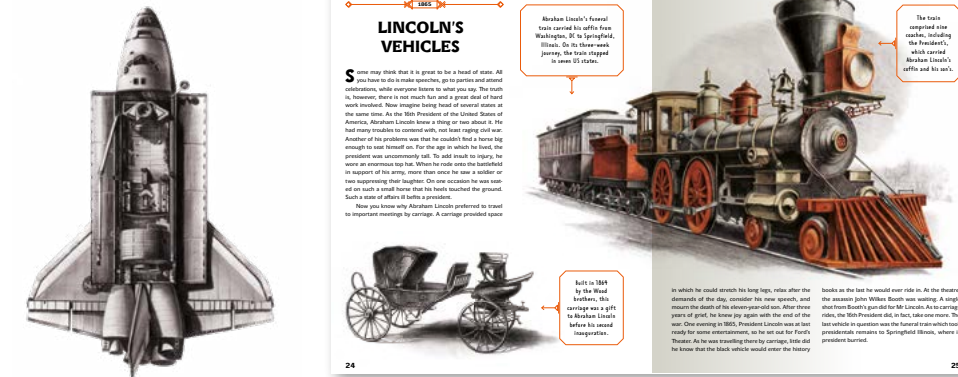
The emperor Caligula is one of the best known and most controversial figures of ancient Rome. He is the emperor who had his horse appointed a senator, carried on long debates with the Moon and had a thing for scuba rituals. So great was his admiration for China, goddess of the East, for Meow and Chao, that he decided to build two enormous ships at Lake Nemi and dedicate them to her. At certain times, the lake reflects the moon to breathtaking effect, which explains why it was known as China's Mirror. The problem was, as no river flowed into the lake, it was impossible to reach by boat. We still don't know how Caligula's ships were carried to the lake.

What we do know – from legends that ended up on the lake's boat, Borgomae like the rule of the road emperor – is that the ships were magnificent floating palaces, nearly one of the wonders of the world. They were splendidly adorned with statues made from precious metals, and they contained drainage and water systems and more. Unfortunately, they were not built to last. In 1944, a young cardinal and nephew of the Pope called Prospero Colonna attempted to pull one of the ships ashore with ropes, but he succeeded in retrieving only a few iron beams.

In 1925, Italian inventor Guglielmo de Lorenza and Francesco de Marchi had more luck when they finally set out to explore the ships underwater in an invention known as the diving bell. By their actions, these two daredevils unwittingly laid the foundations of rescue diving. It wasn't until the year of the 19th World War, however, that the colossal ships they were at, over 10 metres long, were at last pulled from the lake, after discovery of Italy Benito Mussolini had the lake drained. The ships were taken to Rome, where they came to a sorry end in the final days of the war, when the Italian capital was bombarded. Picked over before a fall, they may – two despotic Italian rulers could tell you about that.

The astronomer Johann Bode, for whom Bode's Law is named, invented a diving bell that could breathe with oxygen.

Lake Nemi, which is in the Alban Hills about 30 km north of Rome, is of volcanic origin.



ABRAHAM LINCOLN'S VEHICLES

Some may think that it is great to be a head of state. All you have to do is make speeches, go to parties and attend ceremonies, while everyone listens to what you say. The truth is, however, there is not much fun and a great deal of hard work involved. Now imagine being head of several states at the same time. As the 16th President of the United States of America, Abraham Lincoln knew a thing or two about it. He had many troubles to contend with, not least raging civil war. Another of his problems was that he couldn't find a horse good enough to suit himself on. For the age in which he lived, the president was surprisingly tall. To add insult to injury, he wore an enormous top hat. When he rode onto the battlefield in support of his army, think that once he saw a soldier or two supporting their laughter. On one occasion he was said to be such a small figure that his horse touched the ground. Such a state of affairs is better a president.

Now you know why Abraham Lincoln preferred to travel to important meetings by carriage. A carriage provided space in which he could stretch his long legs, relax after the demands of the day, consider his own speech, and ensure the death of his eleven-year-old son. After three years of grief, he knew his days with the end of the war. One evening in 1865, President Lincoln was on his way to Ford's Theatre. As he was travelling there by carriage, little did he know that the black vehicle would enter the history books as the last he would ever ride in. At the theatre, the actress John Wilkes Booth was waiting. A single shot from Booth's gun did for Mr. Lincoln. As to carriage rides, the 16th President did, in fact, take none more. The last vehicle in question was the funeral train which took presidential remains to Springfield, Illinois, where it was eventually buried.

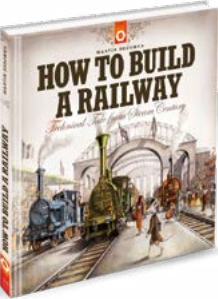
In 1894, by the 18th birthday, the carriage was a gift to Abraham Lincoln before it was sold to a private collector.

The train carried one coach, including the President's, which carried Abraham Lincoln's coffin and his son's.

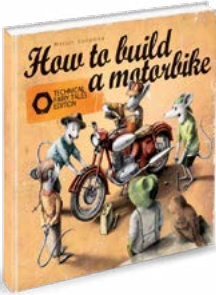

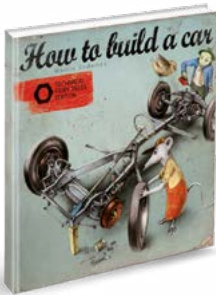

They're all around us. We use them daily, pass them by, and it never occurs to us to stop and think about where they came from. What, you ask? The most ordinary things in the world, of course! Shoes, umbrellas, toothbrushes, toothpicks, socks, dolls, and so on and so forth. How did they come to be? Who invented them, how did they develop and change over time? If you'd like to know the answer to these questions, to peek behind the curtain that drapes the most ordinary stuff in mystery, then definitely read on and learn the story of common things.



SHOES

Have you ever had the splinteriest of all splinters stuck in your foot? Ouch, ouch... If you have, then you know it hurts like hell. Just take a stroll around the garden as you see – with bare feet. Picture it: deep grass, the rising sun. One wants to enjoy the nature with all their senses but oh, oh! Their pampered feet immediately start protesting. "Help! What are you doing to us, you silly little human? The pebbles are sharp, the twigs prickly, and the grass tickles. Put on your shoes, right now! Please, what a relief. Hail to the genius who invented shoes." Well, yeah, but who was it? And what's the story of shoes, anyway?

PREHISTORY

The sides of some prehistoric shoes were made from bear skin. Why bear skin when it's thicker than cowhide and lets more water through? The answer is simple. Bear awakens before dawn but bear skin would give them the strength of this forest animal and protect them.

The first shoemakers

Which material was used to make shoes is prehistoric loss? That's a no-brainer! Some had: fire, bamboo, or palm leaves were more than enough to sew a pair of sandals. If you wanted sturdier footwear, you needed leather or fur.

The Ice Age is coming

Even our prehistoric ancestors used to wear shoes. That's because back then, they travelled from the warm Africa all the way up North. Unaccustomed to the cold, they immediately went about inventing clothing which would allow them to survive the local winter. And since freezing weather didn't do any good to one's feet, either, they came up with the first shoes to wear with their coats. The first "shoes" ever found were made in the Stone Age and boast the impressive 7800 years of age.

ANCIENT EGYPT

Prehistoric times were followed by the antiquity – and by masters of the shoemaking craft to boot. These even could weave sandals from tiny strips, but also saw hard low shoes or waterproof high boots. In Egypt, the job was pretty easy since the arid hot climate required simple shoes – leather sandals that looked like the flip-flops we love today. They were worn mostly by rich men, and also the Pharaoh. When the Pharaoh gave first of wearing shoes, he entrusted them to one of his servants, a so-called sandal-bearer.

Shoe production in Egypt

The leather that went into Egyptian sandals was soft and supple. That's because shoemakers would soak them in a special silty liquid. This would allow the weavers to stretch through a large puddle – if there had been any puddles in Egypt, that is – without having to worry about water getting in, or about the footwear slowly but surely rotting away.

ANCIENT GREEK

Pharaoh's shoes were decorated with beads, gold, semi-precious stones (eg. carnelian) and precious dyes (eg. larch etc.).

Each one was unique, its beauty and magnificence lauded by the greatest poets and writers of the age. Everyone longed to see for themselves the Wonders of the World: the Colossus of Rhodes, the majestic Pyramids of Giza, the Lighthouse of Alexandria, which withstood earthquakes and gales, the spellbinding Statue of Zeus at Olympia, the breathtaking Temple of Artemis in Ephesus, the Mausoleum at Halicarnassus, the Hanging Gardens of Babylon, inspiration for so many myths and legends. Just one of them survives today. But with us you can go back in time and learn the secrets of how these gems of ancient architecture were created. The building of each comprised so many details and small jobs, so much daily grind and sustained effort, with or without the help of machines.

Unlimited working hours!
Those who expected to find their peace after the construction was completed were disappointed. Once everything was finished, the gardens had to be maintained. And again, that required a great deal of working staff. What did they have to do? Fertilizing, weeding, planting, mowing, cutting, shortening, breaking. We know about all that. The most demanding task, however, was irrigation.

Get to work!
The construction of the Hanging Gardens required enormous human resources. Fortunately for the king and unfortunately for the captives, Nebuchadnezzar had many slaves that he had enslaved during his many conquests. Thousands of people worked on the construction, including slaves, architects, engineers, builders, material carriers – who mainly transported a huge volume of soil, as well as plants and exotic trees – and brick manufacturers.

Asphalt and mortar
To make the construction solid, workers reinforced the bricks with clay mortar and asphalt and often added plaster to the mortar. Where the joints had to be sealed, lead was poured over the bricks. Asphalt and felgar, also called bitumen, were often used as well.

Ishtar's lion
The city surrounded by walls accessible through gates. The most famous one is the Ishtar Gate. Its corner was right next to the royal palace. It was lavishly decorated with symbols of gods. There were mighty dragons, symbols of the god Marduk, as well as large bulls celebrating the god of thunderstorms Adad and, above all, symbols of the goddess Ishtar, noble lions.



Archimedeian screw
By turning the screw, the builders were able to take up water and irrigate hard-to-reach places.

Bricks
Bricks were needed the most. Why? Babylon was located in an area with a lack of stone and wood. Stone was imported and only used in exceptional cases for selected structures. Fired and unfired bricks were mostly used in the construction industry. Unfired bricks, which were hollow and filled with clay, were used to build the foundations. Fired bricks, which were used as cladding and at stress points.



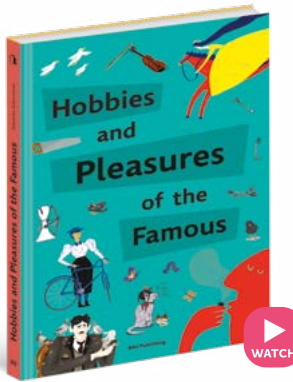
