Songbirds

Eurasian bullfinch
Most birds can be categorized as songbirds. They use singing in order to communicate and let others know where they live. Vocalizations can differ rather substantially between individual species. Some species are excellent composers while others, such as crows, aren't big fans of musical production. Despite their small size, songbirds are very intelligent.

European blue tit
Just like other finches, the plump bullfinch has a strong beak which is just the thing for cracking hard seeds open.

Golden oriole
The beautiful, agile blue tit can be often spotted around human dwellings. It likes to make its home in a nest box so that it can remove insect pests from your garden.

Northern cardinal
The distinctly blue-black rufous most often live in broadleaf forests where you can hear their typical flute-like singing.

European goldfinch
Both the males and females of the European goldfinch are known for their wild colours. You can encounter them in European forests and gardens where they pick seeds.

Bohemian waxwing
A highly winged with a small crest on top of its head, the Bohemian waxwing often make nests in trees, close to other waxwings.

Northern cardinal
The northern cardinal can be found at the edge of forests and in the gardens of South America. The males have a strikingly crimson colour.

Barn swallow
Agile swallows hunt insects while flying. They often use pieces of dirt to glue together nests in the walls or beams of houses. Before the winter arrives, they leave for warmer regions.

Song thrush
The thrush likes to make nests in open forests. It frequently inhabits gardens, just like its cousin, the blackbird with whom it shares a similar diet. Thrushes can break small shells by throwing them against stones.

Kingfisher eggs are nice, shiny and truly tiny. All of them are round except for the last one which can be a bit more oval-shaped. Have a lovely white colouring as camouflage colours are not needed in the dark tunnel hidden from 0.5 to 37 metres above the water surface.

NEST

Kingfisher homes resemble a fish market. Everywhere you look are fish bones, scales and fins. Sometimes the parents have trouble getting back into the nest because of the mess. A hollow is located at the end of the tunnel where the small eggs are hidden. A 15–30 cm tunnel, sometimes measuring more than 1 metre, is dug in the sandy riverbank!

Kingfishers are sworn loners outside the nesting season. They carefully guard and defend their position at slowly flowing and crystal clean streams. They are most fond of locales where branches dip into the water, where they can sit and observe their prey. They are able to submerge up to 30 centimetres under the surface to catch a fish. They grab their prey firmly in their beak and emerge from the surface with the use of their wings. They begin to feast on their favourite perch. They swallow the fish headfirst, so the scales don't scratch their throats!

FISH AND FISH ONCE AGAIN

Immediately upon arrival each youngster eats one fish per hour. The parents are kept extremely busy trying to satisfy so many hungry throats. They often are still partially feeding the almost grown young from the first brood while warning another clutch of white eggs. Despite their small bodies, they are able to pull an up to 12 cm long club from the water! The entire life cycle of the kingfisher is linked, in other words, with fish and it is therefore not surprising that the male gives its chosen as an engagement gift...you guessed it, fish once again.
