The first dirigible was powered by steam. The magnificent giants that sail quietly about today's skies are controlled by modern computer technology and satellite navigation.

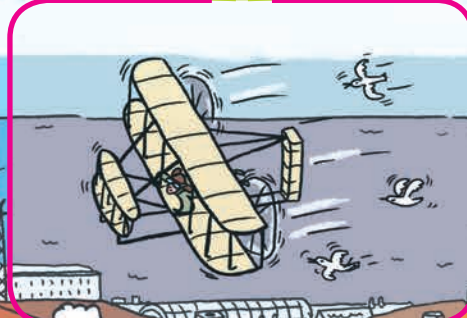
Cars were started by hand-crank.

Riders of the so-called high-wheeler needed not only strength and skill but also courage!

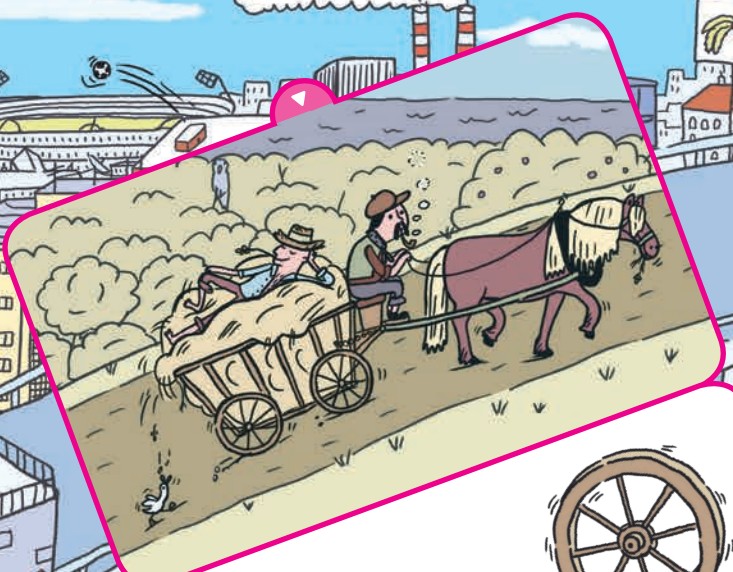

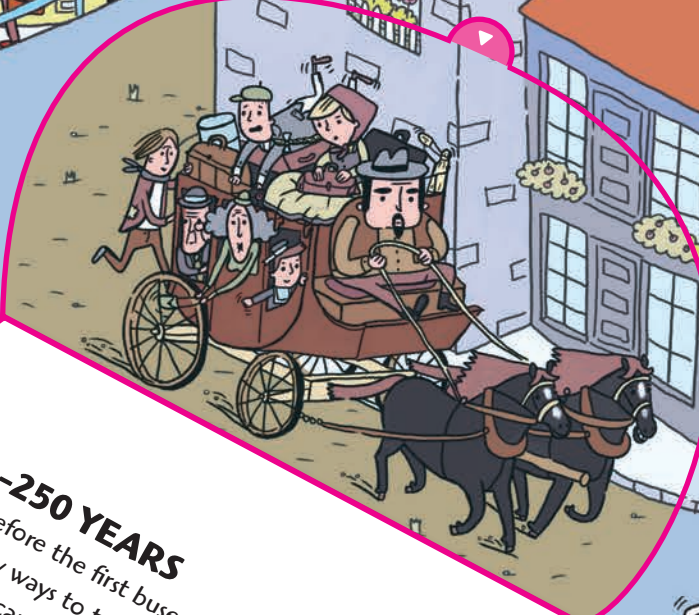
When the first motor-powered aeroplane took to the skies, the flight lasted less than a minute and the pilot was lying down!

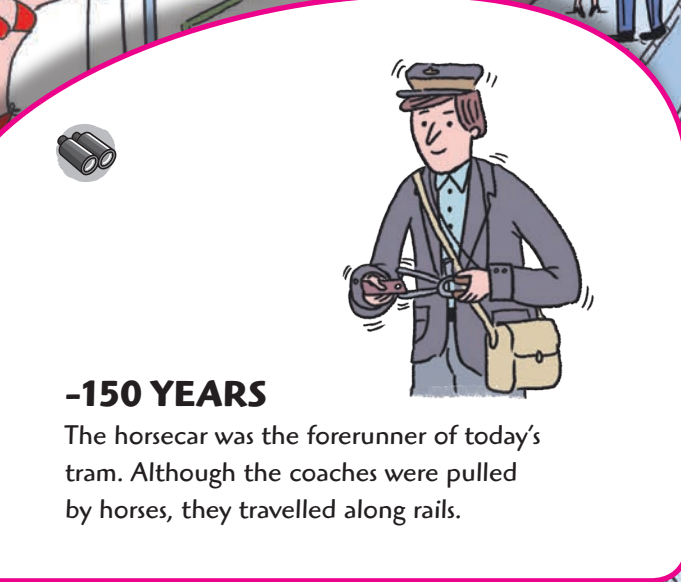
Before the use of railways and lorries goods were transported by road in waggons with spoked wheels.

-200 YEARS



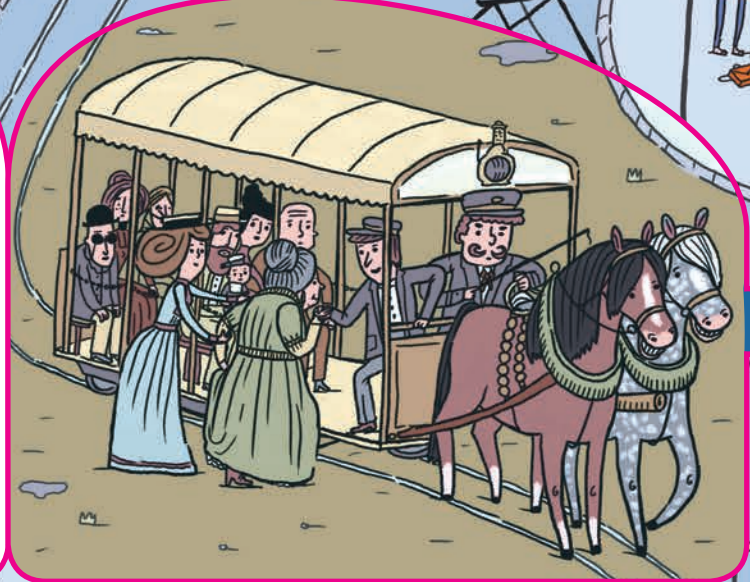

-250 YEARS

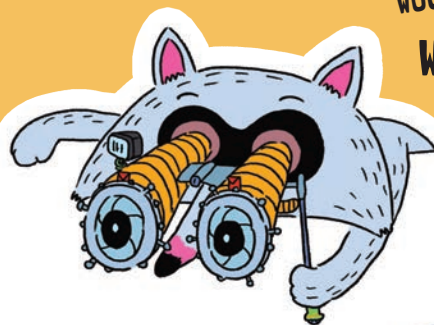


The horsecar was the forerunner of today's tram. Although the coaches were pulled by horses, they travelled along rails.
