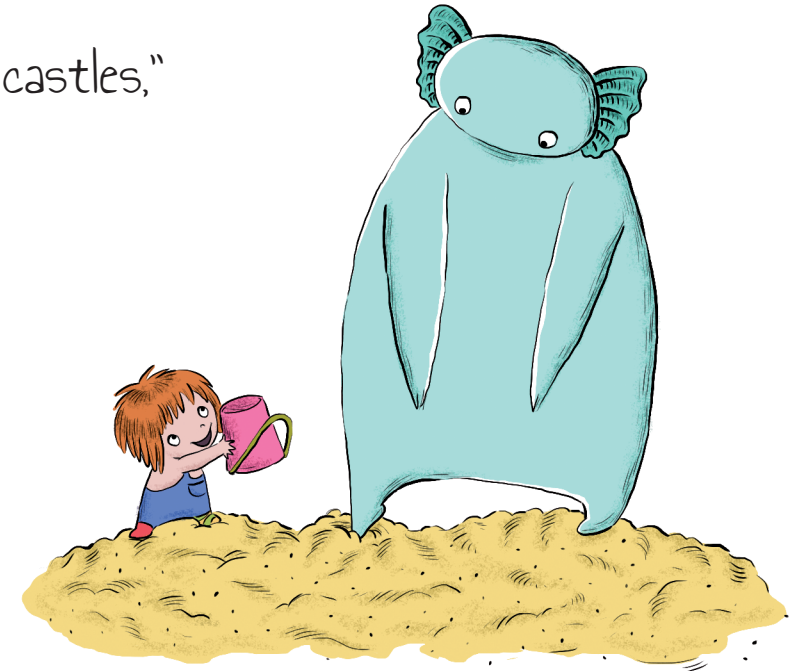
"Let's build a tower out of bricks," said Lily.



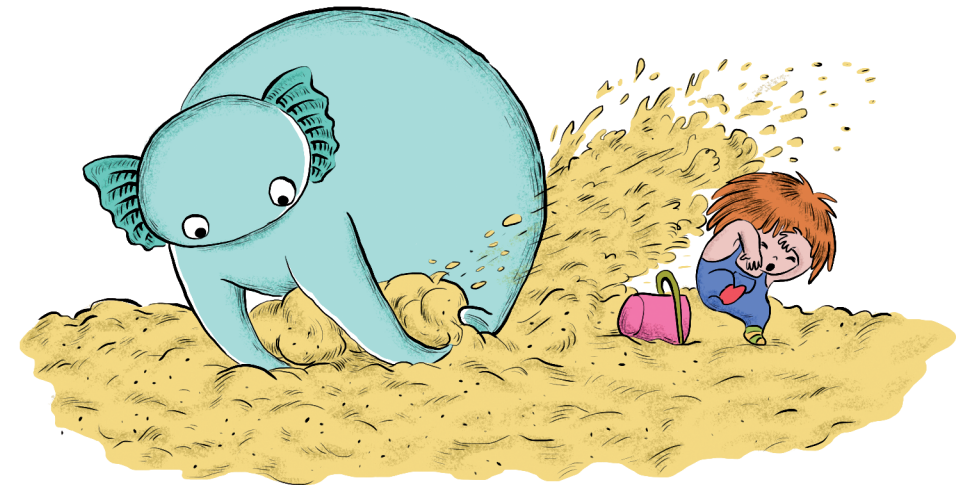
But Momo would rather taste the bricks than build a tower with them.



"Let's build sand castles," suggested Lily.



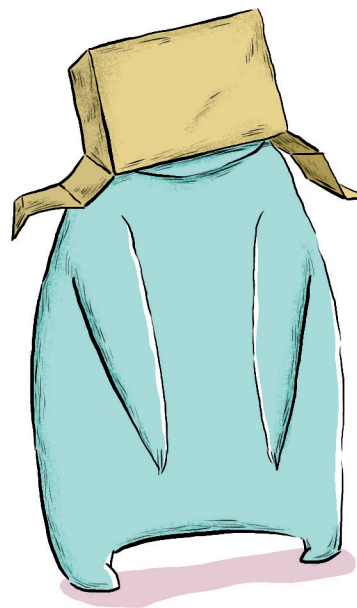
But Momo was too clumsy to build sand castles.



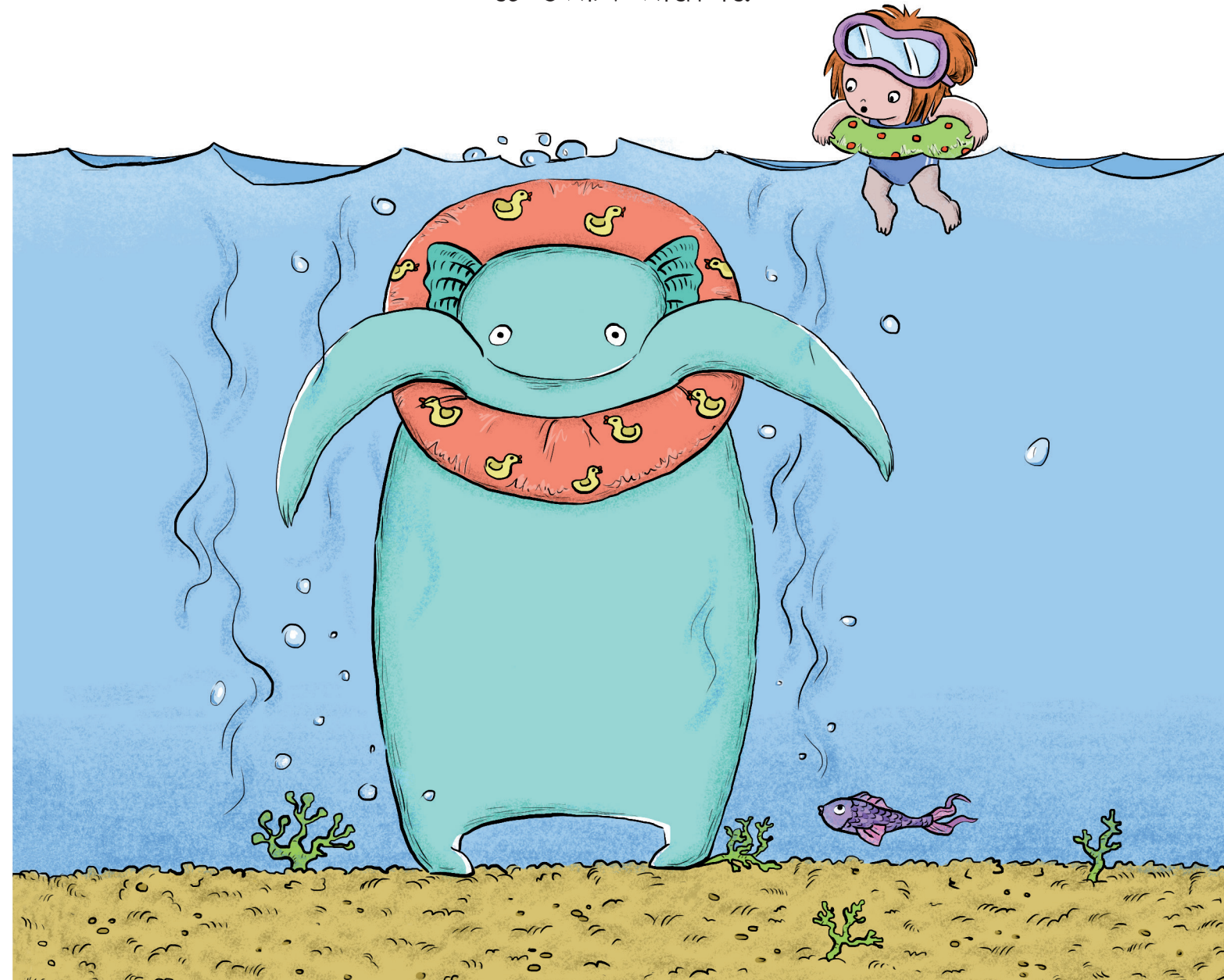


Momo was more interested

What could Lily and Momo play together?

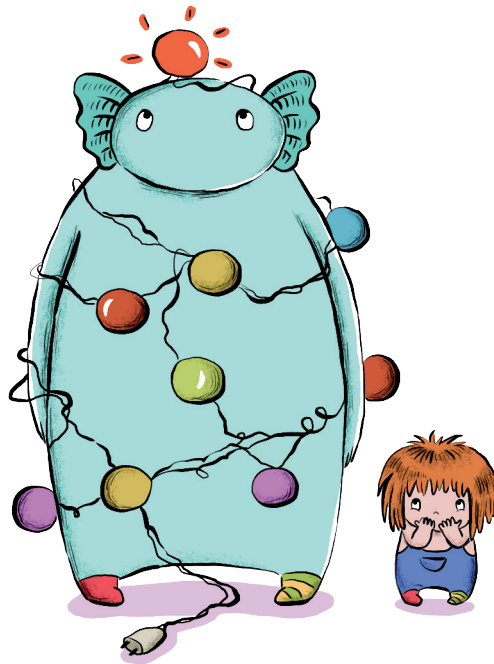


Lily knew that she would come up with something ...
