A CASTLE UNDER SEGE

A castle's inhabitants needed to be prepared for sieges of long duration. If aggressors did not succeed in conquering a castle, they would attempt to starve out its inhabitants by holding the castle so long under siege that the inhabitants ran out of food and were forced to surrender.

Before the invention of gunpowder, aggressors would attempt to undermine a castle's walls.

A curtain wall stood between towers or bastions from which a defensive barrage was mounted from the sides. CASTLES WERE NOT ONLY SCENES OF WAR.

Cultural events at court kept many artists and musicians busy. As science began to develop, alchemist's workshops, astronomer's observatories and extensive libraries originated.

For much of what we know about castles, knights and the Middle Ages in general, we are indebted to the scribes and chroniclers who had to the patience to write everything down.
