## GREAT-GRAND-STATUES

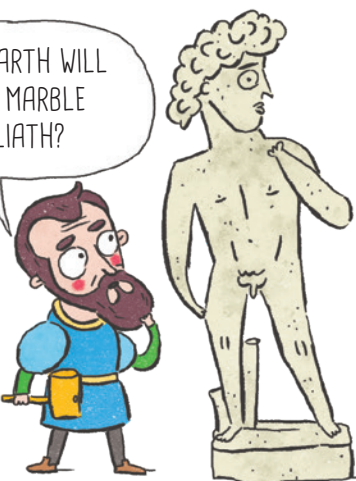
Before long, painting on walls was no longer enough for early artists. They began to carve three-dimensional objects from mammoth tusks and to make models in burnt clay.

## SCULPTORS

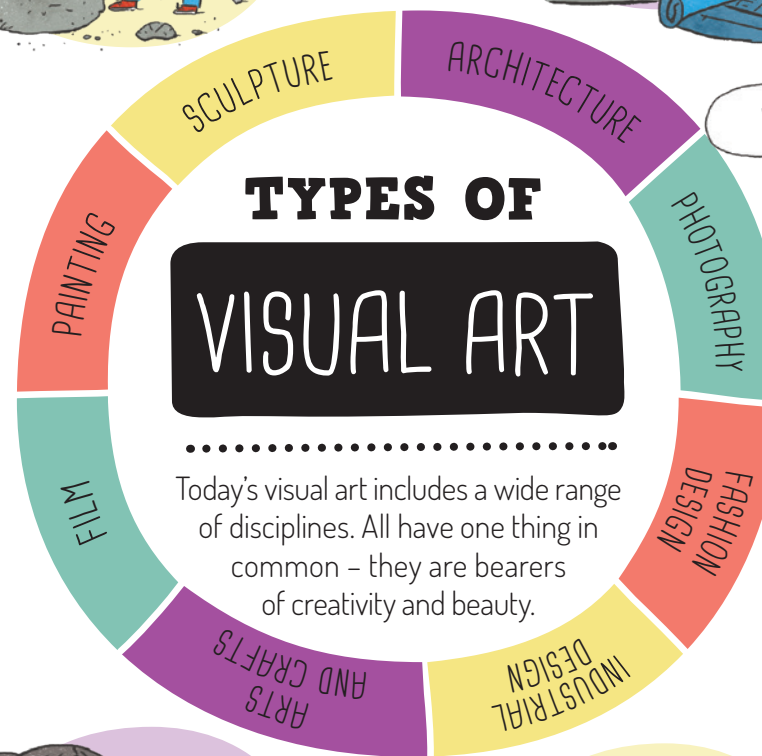
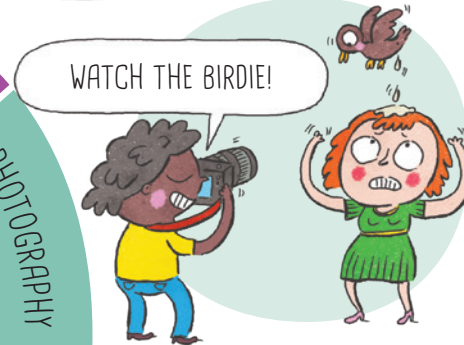
People first surrounded themselves with paintings and sculptures in palaces, temples and churches. Visual artists – painters and sculptors alike – soon became valued citizens.

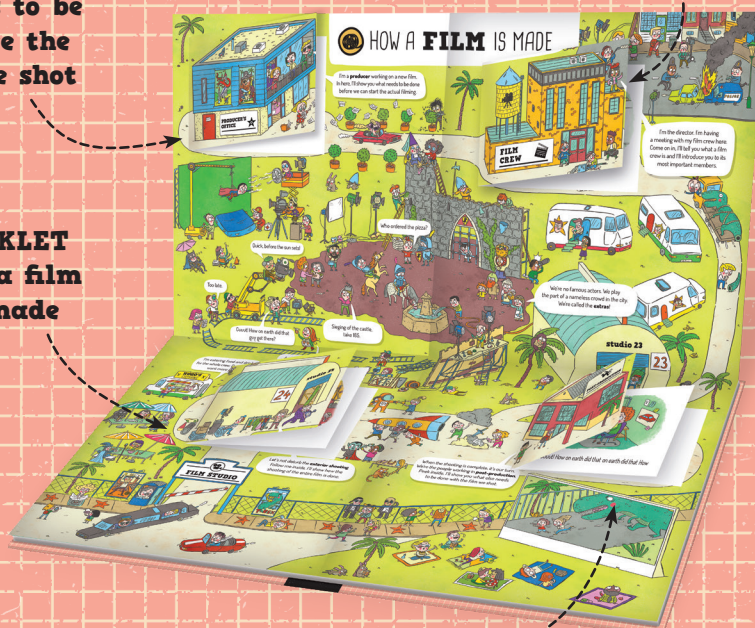

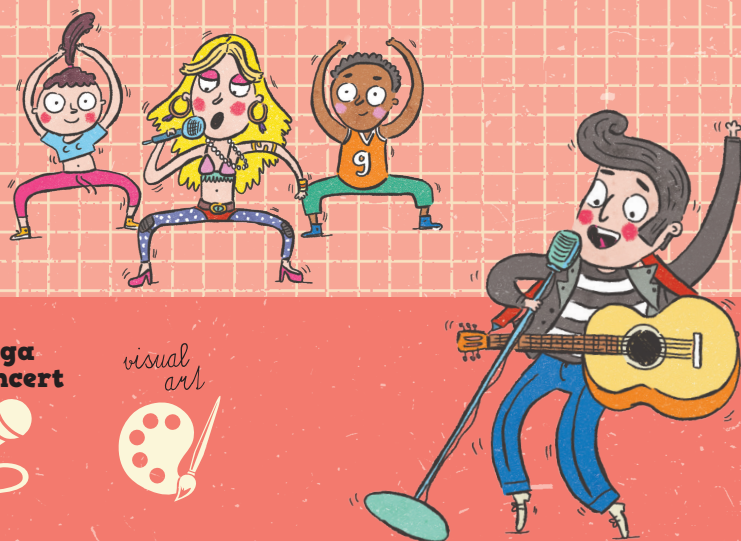
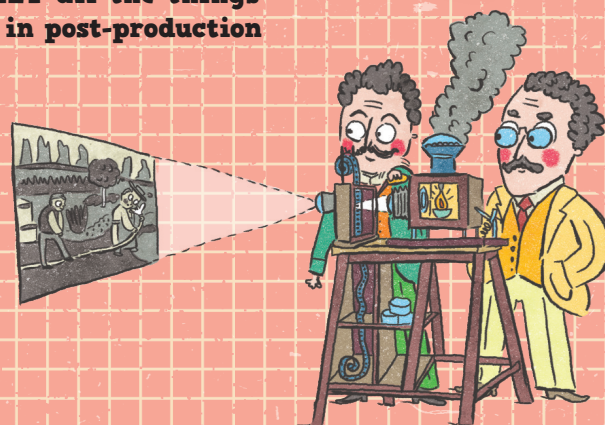
