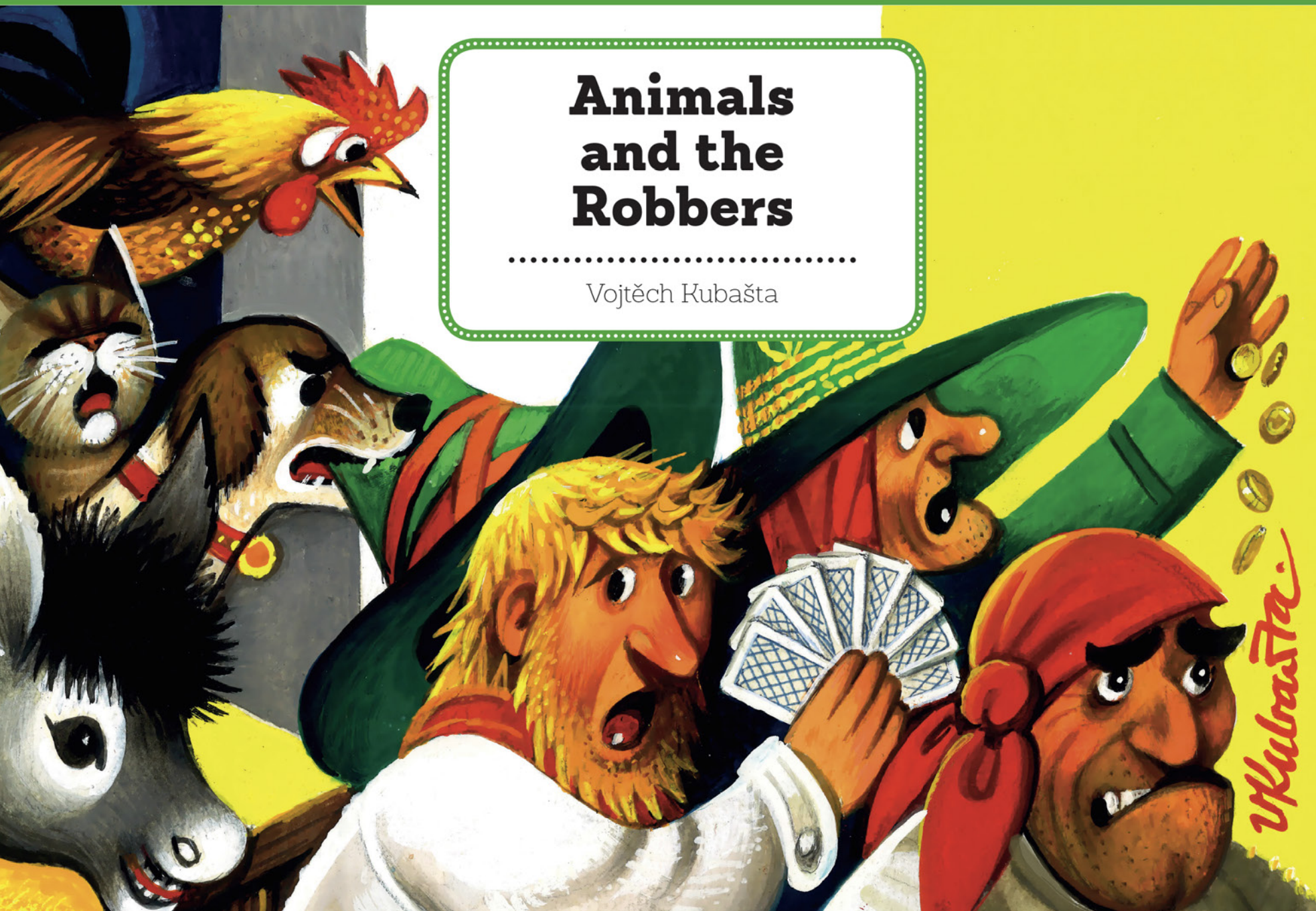




Animals and the Robbers
