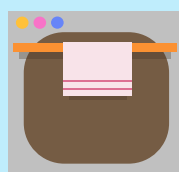
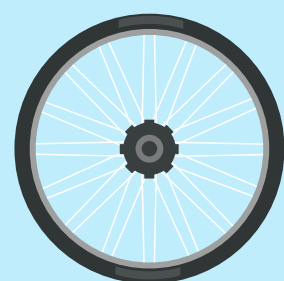
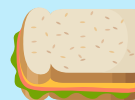
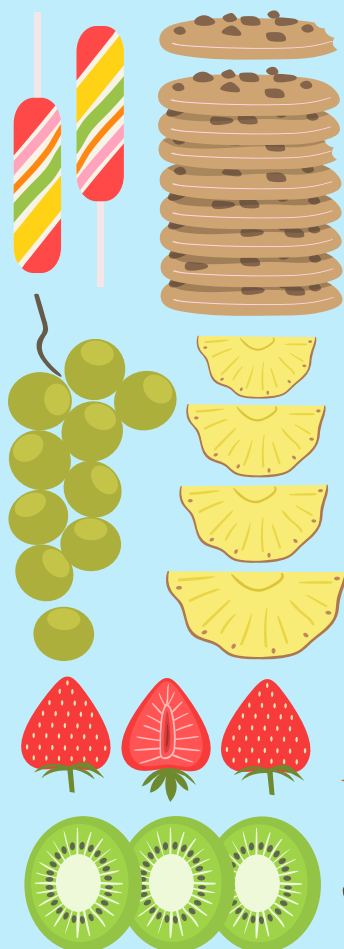


WHAT MAKES THINGS THINGS
