


A DREAM JOB


2. Are you interested in COMPUTERS?


PROGRAMMER

COMPUTER ANIMATOR


A computer animator uses a computer to make drawn figures, objects and text move, so that in the finished film they appear to be moving on their own. Some animators create all figures and objects in advance. Others work with objects provided by a director or art director.





WEB DESIGNER

A web designer designs attractive, clear, functional websites for companies and individuals.



NETWORK ADMINISTRATOR

They are responsible for the operation and intercommunication of all computers in a company or institution.

CYBER SECURITY SPECIALIST

Like a soldier, they protect us against our enemies, using computers and their knowledge of programming instead of weapons.



DIGITAL TERRAIN MODELLER

As commissioned by a client, a terrain modeller creates a digital environment that provides a safe space for training and interventions on unsafe terrain.





APP DEVELOPER

They devise and create new applications for mobile phones and computers.

GAME DEVELOPER

A game developer designs new computer games.






SOUND DESIGNER

They inspire others by the photos, videos, opinions and comments they publish on social media.






3. Do you enjoy CARS, AEROPLANES and other MACHINES?



PILOT

VEHICLE DESIGNER


They apply their imagination and eye for beauty to the design of new vehicles.



They search the universe for hitherto unknown life forms.




PLANET SEEKER

Using telescopes with the highest precision, they search for hitherto undiscovered planets.


ROCKET TECHNOLOGIST

SPACESUIT DESIGNER


They make constant improvements to spacesuits, so ensuring the comfort and safety of courageous astronauts.



An adventurer, they search for historical artefacts, most of which are buried deep in the ground. They conduct research leading to discovery of old buildings, objects, and human and animal skeletons. As they explore our history, many archaeologists travel around the world. They may get to explore the pyramids of Egypt or tombs of the Aztecs. Items they find are kept in museums and safes.





CHEMIST

They understand the world as compounds of atoms, molecules, and minute particles that give all things their characteristic properties. In a laboratory, they conduct experiments and observations by which they find out ever more about chemical substances. Their knowledge can be applied in many fields, most notably medicine, engineering and biology, but also in bookbinding and the textiles industry.

FORENSICS OFFICER

A member of the criminal investigations police, they document a crime scene and look for clues. With their professional equipment they take detailed shots that may lead the investigators to the perpetrator.





RENEWABLE ENERGIES SPECIALIST

They dedicate their life to the search for sources of energy that do not burden the environment or harm our planet.

PHARMACOLOGIST

They study the effects of natural drugs and drugs produced in a laboratory.



HISTORIAN

They spend their life in meticulous study of historical sources, so revealing as much as possible about human history and learning how history has influenced the present.



PALAEONTOLOGIST

A palaeontologist studies fossils, which tell us about life on Earth millions of years ago.



MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNICIAN

They examine samples of biological materials under a microscope and then analyse them. They determine the condition of a patient's health in consultation with a doctor.

OCEANOGRAPHER

This daredevil dives to the ocean deep to explore marine life and the history of the seas.



GENETICIST

Through a microscope they explore human, animal and plant genes, which carry information about the characteristics and origins of a species.

STATISTICIAN

A statistician analyses data with mathematical precision, applying logic to derive facts and information.

BOOKSELLER

A bookseller has channelled their passion for reading into their profession. They must choose carefully which titles to order from publishers for their shop, where stock is sorted on the shelves by category. The best books tend to be displayed in the window. Some booksellers hold events at which well-known writers meet their readers or at which new books are discussed.



WRITER

A writer has a vivid imagination and a way with words. Many writers produce stories or educational materials. Some prefer to write poems or plays for the theatre. Successful writers travel the world giving readings from their books and having discussions with other writers and/or their readers.

JOURNALIST

A journalist is able to write readable, engaging and convincing articles based on what is going on in politics, society and culture. Some journalists write about sport. People turn to such articles to find out about something or to understand it in greater depth. Often, a journalist must acquire information in person and on the spot, by interviewing politicians and experts. This is no work for shy people!





LIBRARIAN

A librarian sorts and otherwise looks after books in a public library. They issue these books to readers who wish to borrow them. The library also holds cultural events.

SCREENWRITER

A screenwriter comes up with stories, situations and spoken dialogue for use in films and TV series.



EDITOR


A creative person with a feel for language, they are in charge of the whole process by which a new book gets made. They cooperate with the illustrator, the graphic artist and the author, and also with the production and publicity departments.



COPYWRITER

A copywriter's head is filled with original ideas. They write the words used in advertisements and promotional materials, which must appeal to as many people as possible.





BLOGGER

Bloggers write about their experiences, opinions and discoveries on websites or social media, which are available to all for a small fee or even for free.



TRANSLATOR

A translator has such a good command of languages that they can translate books and articles from one language to another. Not only is the result identical in content to the original, but it is just as readable and engaging.

GREETING CARD WRITER

They come up with imaginative, witty, pleasing words in beautiful script for inclusion in different kinds of decorative greeting cards.



PROOFREADER

A proofreader detects and corrects the sneakiest errors of spelling, grammar and style in a text.

PAINTER

A painter is a master of art. The works of art they create include paintings and frescoes. They move freely between artistic techniques, using a variety of tools, depending on what they wish to express. A painter often begins their process by making small sketches to try out ideas; only the best of these will be worked up into the final image. People will then admire their work in galleries, and also in the street and in books.

VISAGISTE

A visagiste works in films, in the theatre, or behind the scenes at a concert hall. Their job is to transform performers so that they appear exactly as their role demands. Using special cosmetics, dyes, hairpieces and other aids, they can change actors' hair and skin colour as well as their apparent age. They can even turn them into fairy-tale creatures and animals!



DESIGNER

A designer must have a vivid imagination. Part of their design work is the creation of new forms for a great variety of objects. Some of these objects are decorative, others are practical. Designers are involved in the making of new furniture, décor and fittings on public transport, and they are also active in virtual reality. The designer plays an important role in companies that offer an original range of products.



RESTORER

A restorer uses a great variety of techniques to restore old art objects, paintings, furniture, even whole buildings.

ILLUSTRATOR

An Illustrator works closely with the author of a book, creating pictures that complement the book's plot perfectly.





TATTOO ARTIST

Using tools with sharp points, tattoo artists draw pictures on people's skin, usually following a design of their own selected to reflect the customer's interests and wishes.

COMICS ARTIST

A comics artist combines imagination, artistic talent and a feel for good writing to produce exciting stories in the form of comics.






CALLIGRAPHER

A calligrapher is a master of beautiful handwriting for the creation of text and inscriptions for books, greeting cards, invitations and posters. Sometimes they even create new fonts.

BOOK DESIGNER

A book designer is responsible for a book's appearance. It should be attractive and pleasing to the reader, and it should reflect the book's textual content.





MAKE-UP ARTIST

They put make-up on actors for TV, film and live performances. They also make up brides, models and anyone who wishes to emphasize their best features.

SCENOGRAPHER

A scenographer is in charge of design and realization of costumes and scenery for theatrical productions.

FLOWER ARRANGER

They see flowers as objects of beauty from which works of art can be made. They produce beautiful bouquets for weddings, graduation ceremonies and other special occasions. Their arrangements will animate and brighten up any surface or space.
