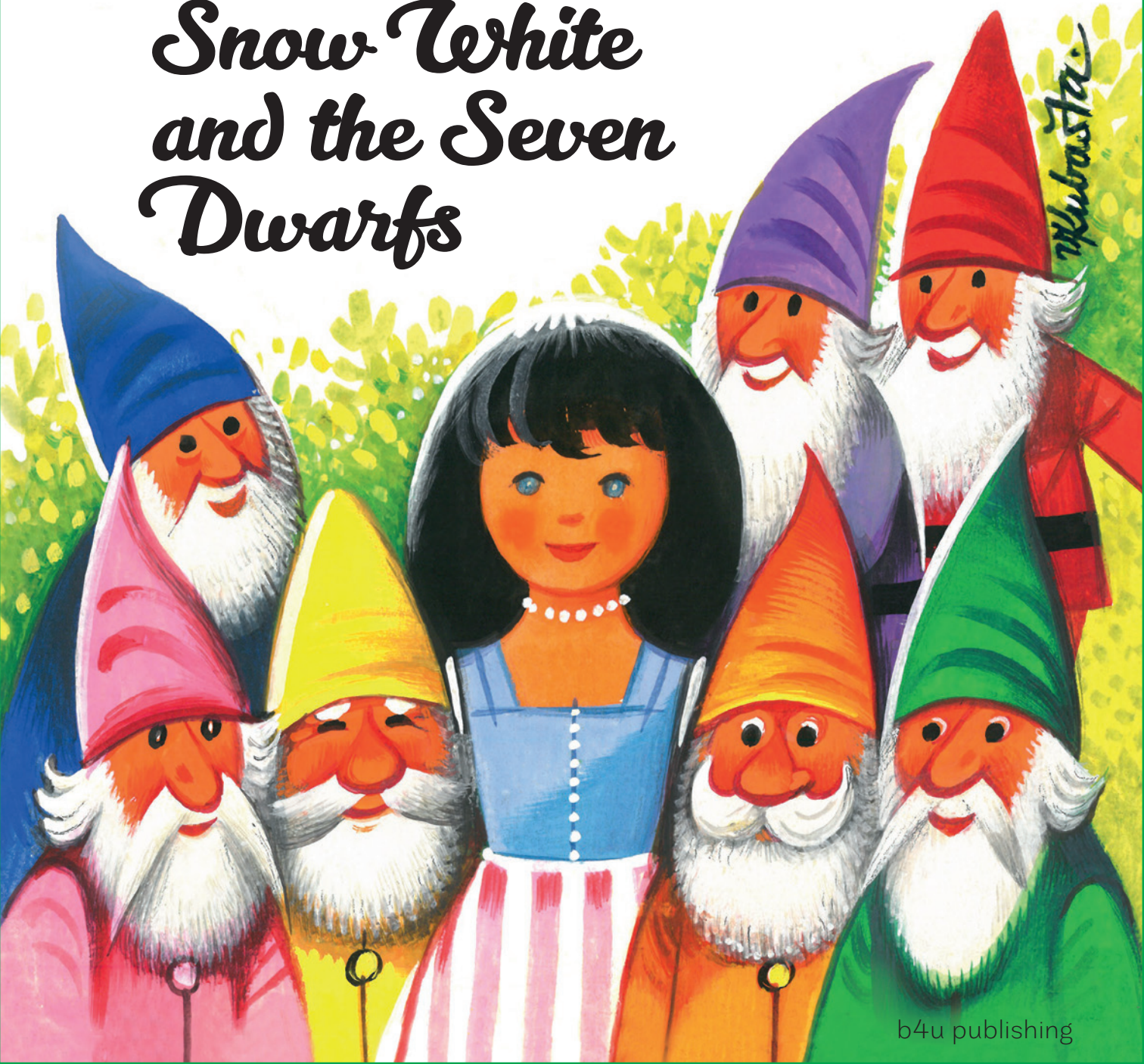




Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs
