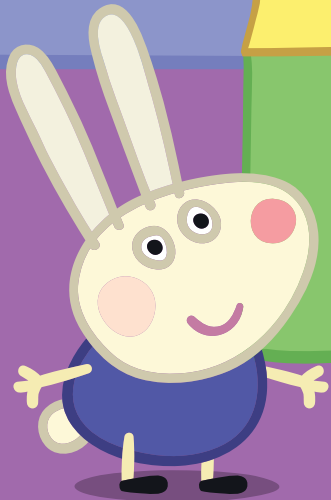


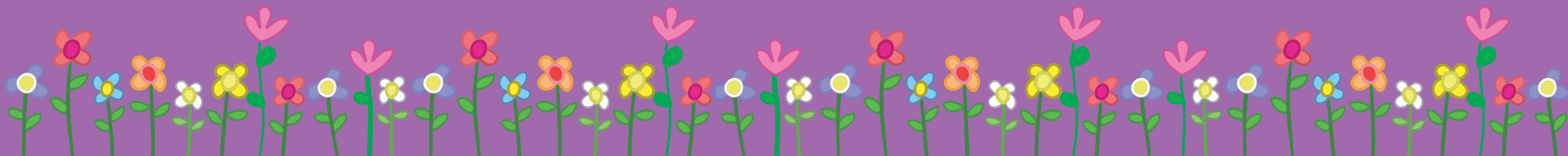

It is beautiful, green and blue."



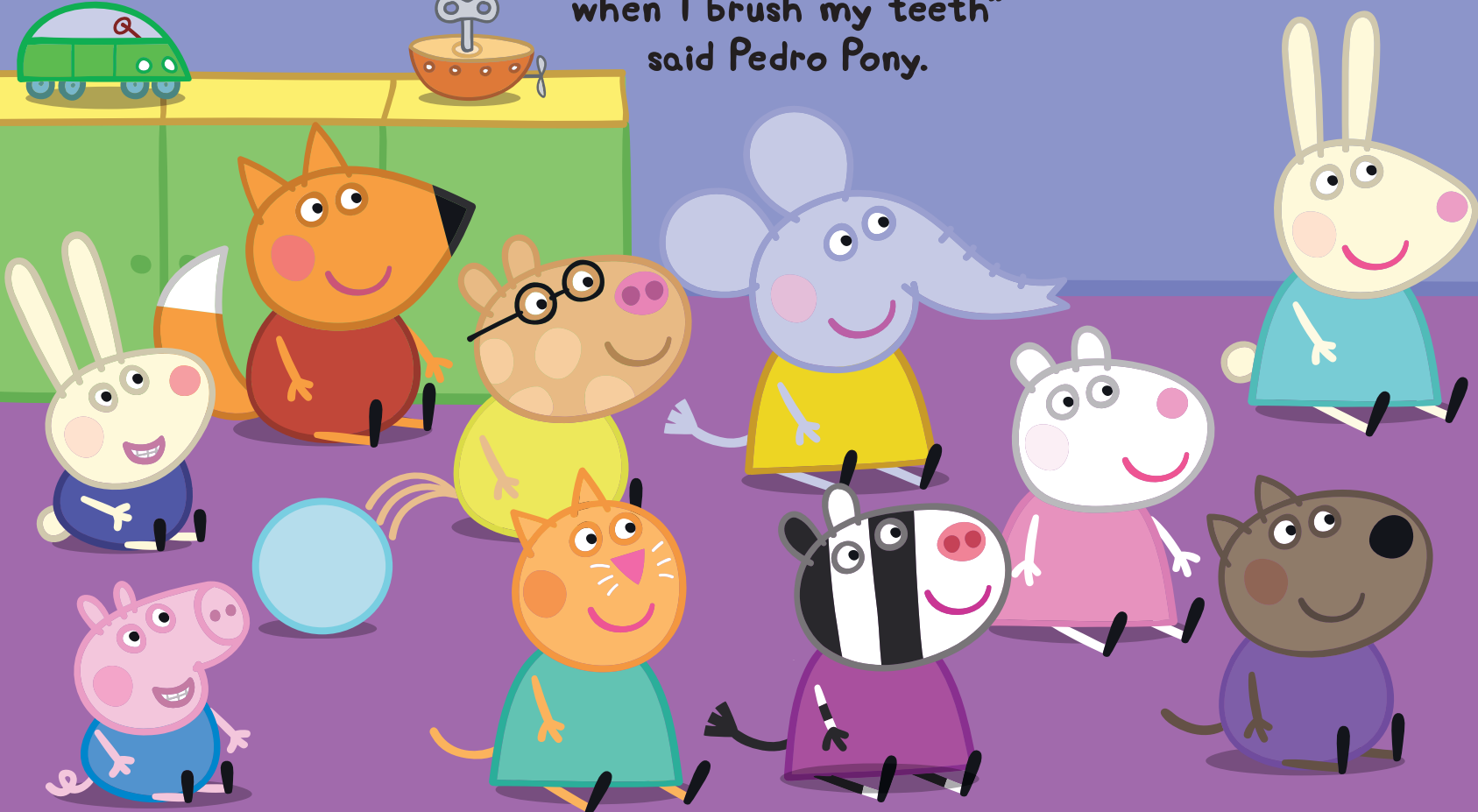
"I turn off the TV every time

The next morning, Peppa and George brought a bin of organic waste to Granny and Grandpa Pig's garden.

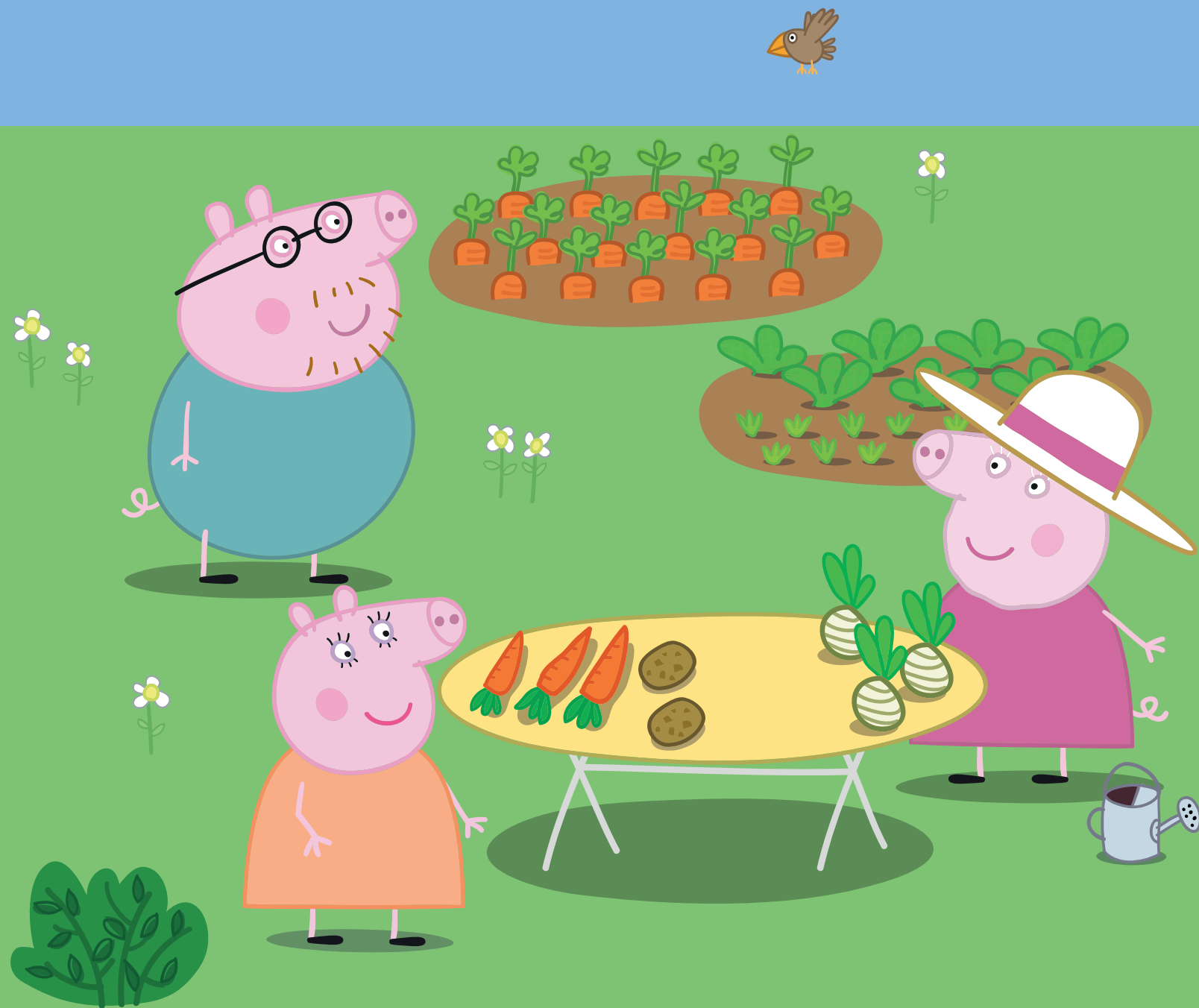
"Thank you, Peppa! In time, this waste will become wonderful compost that will give us beautiful vegetables," Granny Pig praised the children.

"Bzzz, Bzzz!" giggled George.



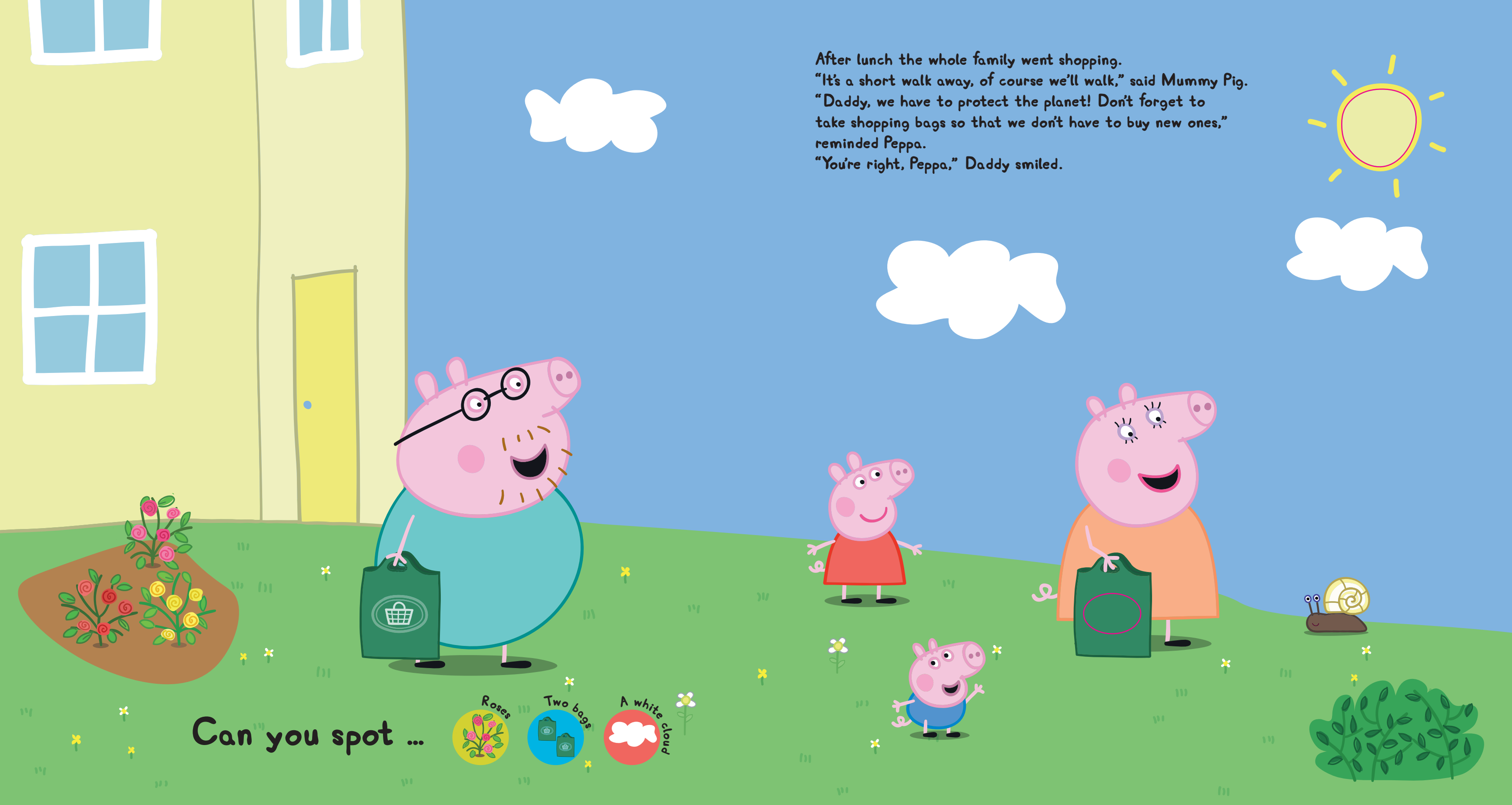
When Peppa and George brought the flower box home, they watered the flowers thoroughly.
