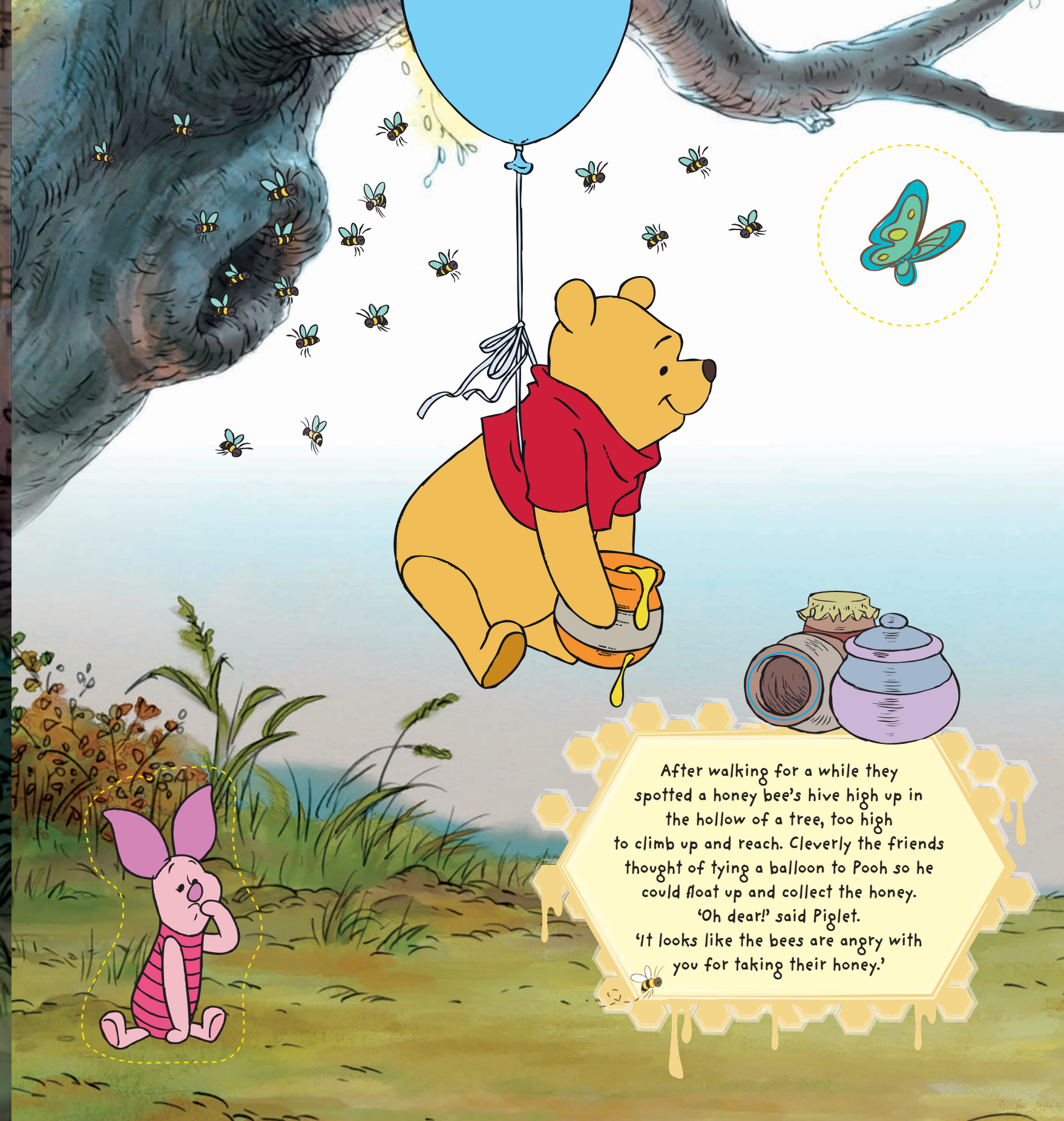
A rabbit

A snail



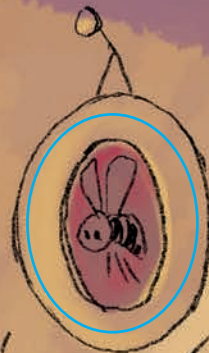
Three leaves
