




CHALLENGES AND JOYS OF WORKING IN A CANDY FACTORY

A theatre actor needs a great memory. That they must remember their lines is a given. And as an actor often has several productions in their current repertoire, they must remember lines from them all.




Actors usually perform in the evening, when most other people have time off.

Good singing and motor skills come in handy for an actor.








CHALLENGES AND JOYS OF THE CAR MECHANIC'S PROFESSION




An artist works even when they appear to be doing nothing. Inspiration is everywhere. But sometimes artists block sets in, and this is very difficult to deal with and get out of.
